Having the right systems in place helps to implement Enterprise Standards of Care, leveraging IDN-wide reporting across Infant Security Systems.

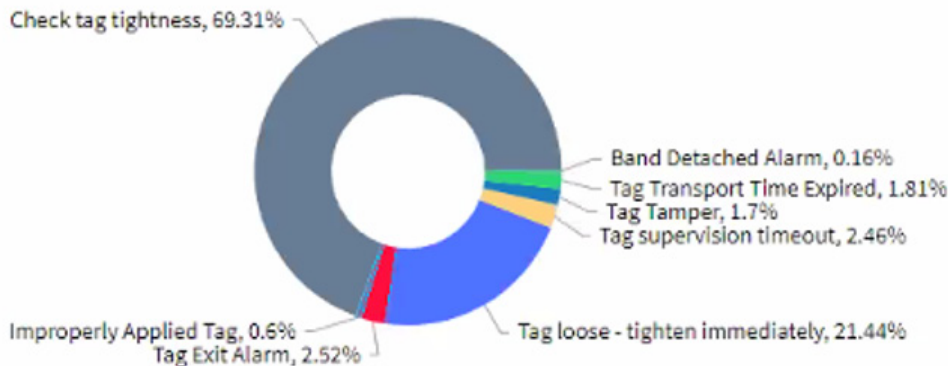

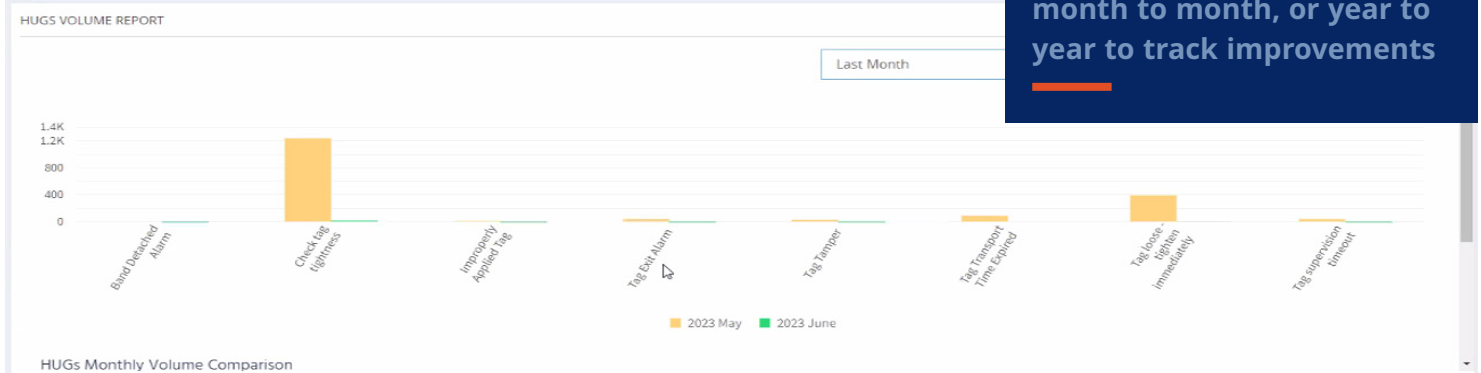
